

Yachtsmen's Fund Scholarship Redemption Instructions

College Sailors Please Note: The Inter-Collegiate Sailing Association (ICSA) does not allow scholarships based on sailing ability. If you are currently a member of an ICSA sailing team, redeeming your certificate(s) could make you ineligible. The Yachtsmen's Fund is prepared to fulfill our obligations. Please hold your certificates and if you step away from your college team, redeem them in a year when you are not sailing or for post graduate studies. Otherwise, upon graduation, unredeemed scholarship certificates can be converted to Keep on Sailing grants to cover training, travel, and/or regatta expenses within two years of graduation. Receipts equal to the certificate(s) value must be provided so plan ahead. The ICSA rule does not apply to Sportsmanship Awards or Junior Power Awards.

Congratulations on your fine performance at one of the I-LYA Junior Regattas. After high school, when you have been accepted into an educational/training program of your choice and are ready to redeem your certificates, please submit the following to our treasurer listed below:

- 1. Scholarship Award Certificate(s)
- 2. Current address, phone number, and email
- 3. Name of your chosen school/program

The Yachtsmen's Fund will send you a check in the amount of your award, payable to both you and your school. You need only endorse the check and present it to the institution.

Scholarships may be redeemed within eight years of the date that they were awarded unless there are special circumstances that prevented earlier redemption.
